Unfortunately, as announced today, the Broken Hill LGA will remain in lockdown, this means that we will continue home learning for next week (Week 10). This will then lead into the school holidays when all the home learning teachers AKA parents can have a well-deserved two week break! Let's hope we have better news for Term 4!

The advice from the NSW Department of Education is that parents and carers must continue to keep children across primary school and school-based preschool – at home unless they need to be at school.

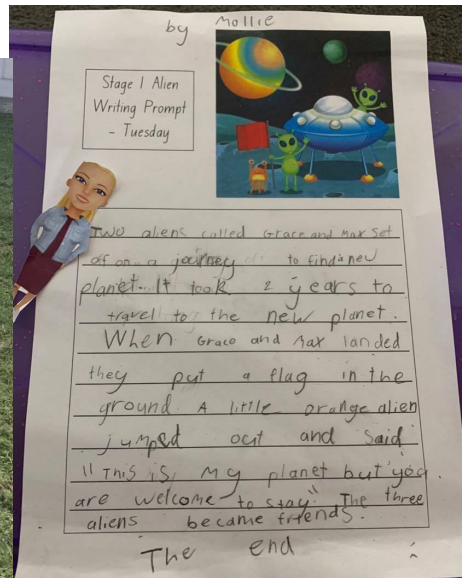
