### Head Lice and Impetigo (School Sores)

We have been notified that there have been a few cases of head lice and impetigo (School Sores) in our school community. Please follow the below information before sending your child back to school. If you need head lice treatment, please contact the office.

<u>Head Lice:</u> Time from infestation to eggs hatching usually 5 to 7 days. Symptoms: Itchy scalp, white specks stuck near the base of the hairs, lice may be found on the scalp. Students can return to school as soon as their hair is treated.

Impetigo (school sores): Time from exposure to illness 1 to 3 days. Symptoms: Small red spots change into blisters that fill with pus and become crusted, usually on the face, hands or scalp. Students can return to school, but scabs must be covered with a watertight dressing.

### **Momentum Program**


Momentum offers tailored online treatment programs to help children and adolescents learn new ways to cope with feelings of anxiety and / or unhappiness. Momentum also offers help with sleep difficulties, as well as information on wellbeing and help seeking, and tips and information about other topics from adolescents.

Momentum has been designed in collaboration with young people, parents, clinicians and researchers. The <u>program is free to</u> use and can be worked through at your own pace in the comfort of your own home.

All programs will help to: Keep track of your anxiety and/or unhappiness, tackle anxiety and/or unhappiness step-by-step until it seems more manageable, manage anxiety and/or unhappiness in the moment with skills that calm your mind and body.
